### DISCUSSION AND APPLICATION

- ❖ Do you think the genealogy in 6:14-15 is just a sidebar or digression in the narrative? Why or why not? What might be some of the reasons we have genealogies included in the Bible?
- ❖ Why is it important to understand the history of the church? What do you know about your spiritual ancestry? How has this shaped your experience and life as a Christian? What does it mean to know that you're not just any name to God, but that he knows you *personally* and has delivered you *personally* into His family?
- ❖ What names in this genealogy do you recognize? Why would the selection of these names be significant to Israel?
- ❖ The point of the genealogy was to authenticate Moses and Aaron as the ones appointed by God to bring the people out of Egypt. Where else does a genealogy help us authenticate God's appointment?
