
Our Mission

What's in a name? Some names we don't give much thought to, but all names tell us something. Names identity and describe what is being named and what we wish to be remembered about someone or something. As we've been thinking about the importance of membership in the church and the distinctives of Trinity Fellowship as a reformed church in our Sunday school this summer, I've been giving some more thought to the name of the church. Don't worry, we're not changing the name! I have great confidence that much thought and discussion went into the naming of Trinity Fellowship, but it's good to be reminded now and then about 'what's in a name'. Over the next few months, I'll share some thoughts on the three words used in the name of this church. I'll also be preaching through a series on the church in our morning worship in August and September. I'm excited to learn and grow with you as Trinity Fellowship Church!

God teaches us that he is one (ex. Deuteronomy 6:4), but the Bible also tells us that there is diversity in God. The Old Testament hints at something more than just a singular reference to God (ex. Genesis 1:26). There is a plurality and complexity to God, and in the New Testament we see that within the one God there is actually three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. To express this truth, we use the term tri-unity or Trinity. We will not read the word trinity in the Bible, but we do see references to the Triune God. In John 14-17 there are at least 50 statements relating Jesus to the Father and Spirit. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit share the divine nature and attributes, but each is unique in their relationship and role within the Godhead. We learn that each person has a distinct role in our salvation—we have been chosen by God the Father (Ephesians 1:3-4), redeemed by God the Son (1 Peter 1:18-19), and regenerated by God the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5).

These figures are distinct but they are not separated. It is my prayer that this church would beautifully represent the unity, love, submission, and diversity of the Triune God.
